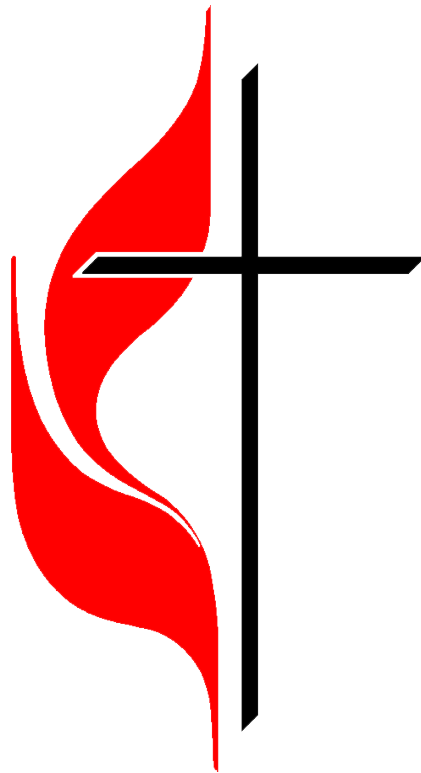

This *Manual of Supporting Tables* has been developed to assist conferences and agencies in establishing consistent standards and practices for sharing key data among annual conferences and general agencies.

It also provides additional guidance and clarification related to annual conference reporting. A clear understanding of each data element and its proper reporting method is essential to improving data accuracy throughout the reporting process.

The General Council on Finance and Administration has worked diligently to update these supporting tables in response to regionalization. References to “Jurisdictional” and “Central Conferences” are retained for consistency with terminology used in *The 2020/2024 Book of Discipline*.

AF	AFFILIATE MEMBER	Clergy who are members of the UMC from an affiliated autonomous Methodist or United Church, and who reside for an extended period in a city or community, may request enrollment as affiliated members of the UMC. They will retain the clergy status of Affiliated Member (AF) unless their membership is transferred to the conference where they are appointed	Clergy
AL	ADMINISTRATIVE LOCATION	This status is assigned when the effectiveness of an associate or full member clergy is under review. Clergy with this designation should also have an appointment status of S00004, indicating Administrative Location	Clergy
AM	ASSOCIATE MEMBER	Clergy members from other denominations who reside for an extended period in a city or community and request enrollment as Associate Members of the UMC will retain the clergy status of Associate Member (AM), unless their membership is transferred to the conference where they are appointed	Clergy
BH	BISHOP	Only historical records of Bishops—specifically during their service within a conference as Local Pastors (LP), Probationary Members (PM), or ordained members—will be updated in GCFA records using information from conference files. Records for currently active Bishops serving in a conference area will be updated exclusively through data from the Episcopal Services (ES) and the Council of Bishops (COB)	Clergy
CC	CERTIFIED CANDIDATE	Individuals who feel called to servant leadership and who have either completed or are beginning the candidacy process for licensed or ordained ministry. Upon appointment, their clergy status will transition from Certified Candidate (CC) to either Part-Time Local Pastor (PL) or Full-Time Local Pastor (FL)	Lay
DC	DEACONESS	Laypersons who have been led to devote their lives to Christlike service under the authority of the Church. Extension ministry appointments only	Lay
DM	DIACONAL MINISTER	This designation is no longer assigned to new individuals. Anyone holding the DM status should have a status change date prior to 1992	Lay
DR	RETIRED DIACONAL MINISTER	Retired Diaconal Minister, consecrated under the provisions of the <i>1992 Discipline</i> or earlier <i>Discipline</i>	Lay
FD	DEACON IN FULL CONNECTION	A clergy member ordained to a lifetime ministry of Word and Service, who is in good standing with the annual conference	Clergy

E00001	Diaconal Ministers	Serving in roles outside of the local church setting
E00003	Appointed to Extension Ministry within UM Connectional Structures (¶344.1.a1-3)	This category includes clergy serving in the UMC's organizational structure, such as conference staff, faculty or staff at UMC-related schools, those serving at UMC camps or retreat centers

E00004	Appointed to Extension Ministry under Endorsement by GBHEM (¶344.1b)	This category encompasses clergy endorsed by the General Board of Higher Education and Ministry (GBHEM). This often includes chaplains, but can also include roles like spiritual directors or pastoral counselors
E00005	Appointed to Extension Ministry in Other Valid Ministries (¶344.1d)	Confirmed by a two- thirds vote of the clergy members of the annual conference. This is a broader category for any other type of extension ministry that aligns with the church's purpose of extending its ministry beyond the local church
E00006	Appointed in other Annual Conferences (¶331, 346.1)	Extension ministry for clergy appointed in another annual conferences that differs from their home conference
E00007	Deaconess and Home Missionary Appointments (¶416.3)	Extension ministry - Used for laypersons (DC) and (HM) assigned to do work within and/or outside of the church
E00008	Assignment For Bishops (¶ 406)	The jurisdictional committee on episcopacy, after consultation with the College of Bishops, shall recommend the assignment of the bishops to their respective residences for final action by the jurisdictional conference; it shall not reach any conclusion concerning residential assignments until all elections of bishops for that session are completed and all bishops have been consulted
E00011	Appointed to Extension Ministry through GBGM (¶344.1c)	These are clergy commissioned as missionaries and serving through the General Board of Global Ministries
E00013	Appointed to Extension Ministry in Ecumenical Agencies (¶344.1.a.4)	Appointments to an ecumenical agency
E00014	Deacons Appointed to a Local Congregation with Missional Responsibility, as a Secondary Appointment (¶331.2d)	In this ministry, the deacons and provisional deacons shall be accountable to the pastor in charge, the charge conference, and other bodies that coordinate the ministry of the local church. In those instances where the appointment is in another episcopal area, the appointment to a local church shall be made in consultation with the bishop of that area
E00015	Local Pastors Serving on Loan (¶318.4)	Local pastors may be appointed for up to five years, either part-time or full-time, in a conference other than the one in which they are certified candidates
E00016	Deacons Appointment to another denomination while retaining their home conference membership (¶331.4)	Appointed to another denomination
E00017	Retired Bishop appointed to Ad Interim Service (¶819.11)	A retired bishop may be called back into active service and assigned to an episcopal area during the interim between quadrennial sessions of the jurisdictional conference
E00018	Appointments to serve beyond the local United Methodist Church (¶343)	Clergy appointed to serve in ministry settings beyond the local UM church
S00001	Discontinued (¶320.1)	Probationary members may request discontinuation of this relationship or may be discontinued by the annual conference upon recommendation of the Board of Ordained Ministry
S00002	Honorable Location (¶ 359.1)	Clergy who are placed on location at their own request

S00003	Honorable Location – Retired (¶ 359.3)	Clergy who are placed on location and request retirement
S00004	Administrative Location (¶ 360)	Clergy member placed on location because it has been determined that the member has demonstrated a pattern of being unable effectively and competently to perform the duties of itinerant ministry
S00005	Withdrawn to Another Denomination (¶ 360.1)	Clergy members in good standing withdraw to unite with another denomination or to terminate their membership in the denomination
S00006	Withdrawn From Ministerial Office (¶ 361.2)	Clergy members in good standing who desire to leave their ministerial office and withdraw from the conference
S00007	Withdrawn Under Complaint (¶ 360.3; 2719)	Clergy member who is named as a respondent to a complaint and desire to withdraw from the membership of the annual conference
S00008	Honorable Location status and clergy orders terminated (¶359.2)	Clergy who is on Honorable Location fail to submit their report for two consecutive years may result in termination of orders upon recommendation from Board of Ordained Ministry and vote at clergy session
S00009	Terminated by Trial (¶ 2713)	The trial court shall have the power to remove the respondent from professing membership, terminate the conference membership and / or revoke the credentials of ordination or consecration of the respondent
S00010	Suspended (¶ 363.7; 2701; 2713)	When deemed appropriate a clergy member may be suspend from all clergy responsibilities
S00011	Deceased	A status indicating an individual has died
S00012	Involuntary Leave of Absence (¶ 355)	Clergy placed on leave of absence by the request of the bishop and the district superintendents
S00013	Family Leave (¶ 354.2.b)	Clergy who, because of an immediate family member's need for full-time care, are temporarily unable to continue in a ministry appointment
S00014	Sabbatical Leave (¶352)	A leave taken for program of study or travel approved by the conference board of ordained ministry
S00015	Medical Leave (¶357)	Clergy who are unable to perform their duties because of incapacity due to health matters
S00016	Transitional Leave (¶354.2.c)	Clergy who are temporarily between appointments
S00017	Diaconal Minister Extended Leave (¶ 313.1e (1992))	In exceptional circumstances an extended leave may be granted upon the approval of the conference Board of diaconal Ministry
S00018	Terminated Diaconal Minister (¶ 313.1e (1992))	A diaconal minister whose relationship to the conference has been terminated (Voluntary or Involuntary)
S00019	Personal Leave (¶354.2.a)	Clergy who self-determine for personal reasons that they are temporarily unable or unwilling to continue in a ministry appointment
S00020	Maternity or Paternity Leave (¶ 356)	Clergy who so requests with the birth or arrival of a child into the home for purposes of adoption

S00022	Mandatory Retirement (¶358.1)	Clergy who will have attained age seventy-two on or before July 1 in the year in which the conference is held
S00023	Voluntary Retirement (20yrs) (¶358.2.a)	Any clergy member who has completed twenty years or more of service under appointment
S00024	Voluntary Retirement (30Yrs, Age 62) (¶358.2.b)	Clergy who will have attained age sixty-two on or before July 1 in the year in which the conference is held or will have completed thirty years of service under appointment
S00025	Voluntary Retirement (40 Yrs, Age 65) (¶358.2.c)	Clergy who will have attained age sixty-five on or before July 1 in the year in which the conference is held or will have completed forty years of service under appointment
S00026	Involuntary Retirement (¶ 358.3)	Clergy placed in retired relation by a two-thirds vote of the board of ordained ministry and the cabinet
S00027	Clergy Appointed to Attend School (¶331.1c, 338.4, 416.6)	Clergy appointed to attend any school, college, or theological seminary listed by the University Senate
S00029	Retired (¶320.5,358,408,549)	Clergy who have retired. This can be used as a general appointment to retirement when the specific retirement category is not known
S00030	Vocational Retirement (¶ 408.2b)	A bishop who has served at least eight years in the episcopacy may seek retirement for vocational reasons and may be so retired by the jurisdictional or central conference committee on episcopacy on recommendation by the involved College of Bishops
S00031	Resignation (¶ 408.4)	A bishop may voluntarily resign from the episcopacy at any time. A bishop may resign from the office by submitting his or her resignation to the Council of Bishops
S00032	Not Appointed	Consult the annual conference for specific guidance regarding not appointed status, as its definition, implications, and requirements may vary across conferences
S00033	Approved but Not Appointed (¶315)	A Local Pastor who has met the educational requirements set by the Board of Ordained Ministry and is cleared to served but has not yet been assigned/appointed to a local church or extension ministry by the bishop
S00034	Inactive	Consult the annual conference for specific guidance regarding inactive status, as its definition, implications, and requirements may vary across conferences
S00035	Voluntary Leave of Absence (¶354)	This code is to be used for historical reference purposes. Voluntary Leaves of Absences have now been broken into types such as personal, family, transitional, etc.
S00038	Formational and Spiritual Growth Leave (¶351.1)	Clergy engaging in continuing education for ministry, professional development, and spiritual formation and growth in order to lead the church in fulfilling the mission of making disciples
S00039	Provisional Members – Voluntary Discontinuance (¶327.6)	Provisional members may request discontinuation of the relationship
