




GCORR Ministry Model

CORR Action Fund

Conflict resolution - exploring and implementing methods and processes to end conflict and retaliation, bringing about peaceful solutions for all parties.

Education about oppression - educating people to recognize the rights of the oppressed and to defend them for and with them.

Intercultural competence - developing skills to foster authentic intercultural relations

Leadership development - encourage leadership among youth and young adults (as defined by your conference)
